HONOLULU, HAWAII

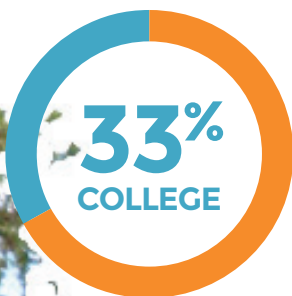

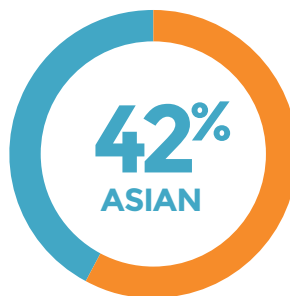
